A. THE WESTSHORE COMMUNITY FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP & BURSARY FUND:

Established in 2005 and by far our largest scholarship fund, this Fund seeks to assist students within our mandate to pursue a post-secondary education.

The Westshore Community Foundation High School Scholarships are given from this Fund and are specifically given to FIRST YEAR post-secondary students graduating from Gimli High School and Riverton Collegiate. Recipients must demonstrate high potential for success, achieve respectable academic grades and be actively involved in community service and/or volunteerism.

Apply through Gimli High School and Riverton Collegiate.

The Westshore Community Foundation Scholarships are given from this Fund to SECOND YEAR & LATER YEAR students and to MATURE students pursuing post-secondary education.

Apply directly to Westshore by July 15 each year. Refer to the Application and Application Guidelines elsewhere on this website.

B. THE CAROLE ANN CLARK MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP & BURSARY FUND:

Established in 2008 from a bequest by the late Carole Ann Clark, this Fund seeks to assist students (Second and later year students and Mature students) within our mandate to pursue post-secondary education. Preference is given to students pursuing studies in the field of education/teaching.

Apply directly to Westshore by July 15 each year. The Applications for the Westshore Community Foundation Scholarships are automatically considered for this scholarship also.

C.THE ALISON OLSON MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP & BURSARY FUND:

Established in 2014 from a bequest by the late Alison Olson, this Fund seeks to assist students (Second and later year students and Mature students) within our mandate to pursue post-secondary education.

Apply directly to Westshore by July 15 each year. Applications for the Westshore Community Foundation Scholarships are automatically considered for this scholarship also.

D.THE LARRY & HELEN KRISTJANSON FAMILY BURSARY FUND

Established in 2011, this fund provides a bursary annually to assist a Gimli High School student who has good potential and needs financial assistance to pursue a post-secondary education goal. Academic grades, extracurricular involvement, and community volunteer services are also taken into consideration.

E.THE LILJA MARTIN MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP FUND

Established in 2015 by the Martin Family in memory of their late mother, Lilja Martin. Lilja was a well-known piano teacher in the Interlake Region for many years. She was an Inspiration to her students and made an enduring contribution to the musical culture of our community. This Fund provides scholarships annually to worthy piano students participating in the Evergreen Festival of the Arts.

These scholarships are awarded to piano competitors at the Evergreen Festival of the Arts.

F.THE DR. ELAINE SIGURDSON MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

Established by the Sigurdson Family in 2018 in memory of their beloved daughter and sister, the late Dr. Elaine Sigurdson. This Fund supports students who have graduated from the Evergreen School Division pursue studies in the Undergraduate Medical Education Program and the Master of Physician Assistant Studies Program at the University of Manitoba.

Awarded by the University of Manitoba to a student accepted for enrolment in the above Programs who are graduates of Gimli High School, Riverton Collegiate or Arborg Collegiate.
